**Denver Metroplex Outreach Briefing**  
Arapahoe County Government Administration Building  
Tuesday, August 23

The Federal Aviation Administration's Next Generation Air Transportation System, or NextGen, is the ongoing transformation of air traffic control technologies and procedures in the United States. The Denver Metroplex project is a comprehensive proposal to improve the flow of air traffic into and out of the Denver Metro area by making the airspace safer and more efficient.

The project proposes to replace several existing conventional air traffic procedures with new satellite-based procedures, which are a key component of the FAA's NextGen. The Denver Metroplex proposal encompasses the Denver metro area and includes eight airports.

- Denver International
- Centennial
- Rocky Mountain Metropolitan
- Front Range
- Northern Colorado Regional (formerly Fort Collins-Loveland Municipal)
- Greeley-Weld County
- Vance Brand
- Buckley Air Force Base

It is incumbent upon the Federal Aviation Administration to engage the community as we implement NextGen, including satellite-based procedures. At this stage in our Denver Metroplex procedure design, we are conducting and planning several community involvement events.

During the week of August 22, FAA Northwest Mountain Regional Administrator, KC Yanamura, and Deputy Regional Administrator, David Suomi, will conduct briefings to several groups, including congressional staff, state and local select officials, airport managers, and aviation industry groups, among others. The briefings will include an update on Denver's airspace modernization, Denver Metroplex study and design work, planned outreach, and timelines for implementation.
