On January 26, 2013 at about 12:45 AM, Deputies Gray and Luton arrived at the Sheriff's Office substation and noticed something had been placed in the glass portion of the front door. As Deputy Gray approached he noticed broken glass and that it appeared that forced entry had been accomplished. Through the front window, Deputy Luton noticed a male subject walking around inside. The male subject had a Sheriff's Office ballistic shield held up to his chest area. The male subject was also observed near the gun safe, attempting to open it. The deputies attempted to gain entry through the front door, however were unable due to the door being blocked from the inside.

Additional deputies responded and established a secure perimeter of the substation. Repeated commands were given to the subject to exit the substation. The subject did not comply with the commands of the deputies. Phone calls were placed into the substation and the suspect answered the phone "Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office". The suspect continued refuse orders to exit the building.

After approximately 10 minutes of giving commands, the subject came out the front door. Again the subject refused to comply with directions of the deputies and began walking towards them in an aggressive manner. Deputy Cook deployed K9 Orry and the K-9 engaged the suspect. The subject struggled with K9 Orry and was eventually taken into custody. The subject is identified as :

The suspect was taken to an area hospital for treatment of a K9 bite to the upper left arm. The suspect stated he broke into the substation because he is ill from the flu and is homeless.

The suspect is being held at the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Detention Facility on a \$50,000.00 bond. The suspect will be charged with 2nd Degree Burglary (a felony), Criminal Mischief and Obstruction (both misdemeanors).
