Search at Cherry Creek State Park

On June 1, 2013, the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office was contacted by employees of Colorado Parks and Wildlife regarding what was believed to be a human jaw bone that was discovered at Cherry Creek State Park. As a result of this discovery and further investigation conducted by the Arapahoe County Coroner's Office, the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office and Colorado Parks and Wildlife, a search of a specific area of Cherry Creek State Park will begin at 1:00 PM today.

The Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office and Colorado Parks and Wildlife will be searching an area on the east side of the reservoir, between the dam and the swim beach.

Update

A broad area of shoreline and water at Cherry Creek State Park was searched yesterday. As a result of the search, additional suspected bone fragments, which are not believed to be human, were collected and will be analyzed. Investigative work will be conducted, in conjunction with other area law enforcement agencies, to compile and review missing persons and other cases. The Sheriff's Office will also be awaiting test results on the human jaw bone, which may take several months.
