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## **County seeks comment on housing and community development plan** *Action plan will guide federal grants for public facilities, services and housing*

**Littleton, Colo.** – The Arapahoe County Division of Housing and Community Development invites public comment on how it should prioritize federal funding for housing and community development projects in 2013. The funding may be used for improving affordable housing, improving or creating public facilities or infrastructure, and supporting public agencies that serve low to moderate-income residents.

The Division of Housing and Community Development will host a special public hearing and presentation on its 2013 Action Plan, 6:30 – 8:30 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 6 at the Arapahoe County Administration Building, 5334 S. Prince St., Littleton in the West Hearing Room.

Attendees will learn how the County proposes to allocate federal Community Development Block Grants and HOME Investment Partnership Act Funds to local agencies who submitted applications last year. These funds are distributed by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and can be allocated to local projects and agencies serving Centennial, Deer Trail, Englewood, Glendale, Greenwood Village, Littleton, Sheridan and unincorporated Arapahoe County. The City of Aurora receives separate funding.

Arapahoe County welcomes citizen input, especially from low and moderate-income residents in the areas where housing and community development funds may be used.

Public comment will be accepted following the presentation and will be added to the County's 2013 Action Plan.
