Aurora, Colo. – Bring the entire family for a day of fun at the FREE [Block Party and Grand Opening](#), 11 a.m. to 2 p.m., June 25 at the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds and Park, 25690 E. Quincy Ave., Aurora, two miles east of E-470 at exit 13.

With indoor and outdoor activities, families will enjoy music, a petting farm, bounce houses, free snow cones, a food truck, heritage activities and giant yard games, face painting, photo booth, K-9 demonstrations and more.

The Arapahoe County Fairgrounds and Park is not only the permanent home of the County Fair, but also an expansive venue that can host everything from trade shows and receptions to sporting events, conferences, festivals, animal shows and more.

Arapahoe County Commissioners will celebrate the official opening of the new and expansive west wing Exhibition hall and the first phase of completion on the 110-acre park with a ribbon-cutting ceremony at Noon.

The Exhibition hall can accommodate larger commercial trade shows, regional athletic events and an extended line-up of festivals and animal-related shows. It also can serve as a training or conference facility, opening the doors to new customers.

The new main entrance winds through the park, which also includes a central green with walkways and a picnic shelter, natural surface trails, and water features that includes a natural meandering stream play area. The skyline at the Fairgrounds is known for the water tower standing tall above the plains. New additions to the grounds also include historic replica windmills that line the park and serve as a reminder of our western way of life.
