## **Arapahoe County to close Motor Vehicle offices, three buildings on Nov. 6 Election Day for non election-related services**

*Closing buildings will free up parking, staff to assist with General Election*

**LITTLETON, CO ---** On Tuesday, the Board of County Commissioners – at the request of Clerk and Recorder Nancy A. Doty – approved closing six locations to free up County staff and parking for the public in order to accommodate the anticipated heavy voter turnout on Nov. 6 Election Day.

Arapahoe County will close the Administration Building, CentrePoint Plaza and the Public Works and Development office at Lima Plaza. County Motor Vehicle branch offices in Aurora, Byers, Littleton and Centennial will be open for election services and will not process driver's license or automobile registration renewals or applications on Election Day.

The building closures include:

- Administration Building at 5334 S. Prince St., Littleton (The Administration Building will be open, but all County services will be closed to the public EXCEPT the Recording Division and Elections Division.)
- CentrePoint Plaza, 14980 E. Alameda Dr., Aurora. (Vote Center site)
- Public Works and Development at Lima Plaza, 6924 S. Lima St., Centennial (Arapahoe/Douglas Works!, Judicial Services and Open Spaces will be open as normal.)
- Aurora Motor Vehicle Branch Office, 490 S. Chambers Road (open for election-related services only)
- Byers Motor Vehicle Branch Office, 538 N. Highway 36, Byers (open for election-related services only)
- Centennial Motor Vehicle Branch Office, 6954 S. Lima St., Centennial (open for election-related services only)

In addition, the Board of County Commissioners canceled their Nov. 6 public hearing and study sessions.

The Administration Building will serve as a drop-off site for mail-in ballots and CentrePoint Plaza and Lima Plaza will serve as Vote Center sites on Election Day. The Administration Building, Centrepoint Plaza and

Lima Plaza will be open to the public for election-related services. Recording services also will be available at the Administration Building.

All other County buildings, including the Sheriff's Administration and Coroner's Facility in Centennial, Arapahoe/Douglas Works! at Lima Plaza in Centennial and Human Services at Arapahoe Plaza in Littleton, will be open Tuesday, Nov. 6 to the public as normal.

County employees will work as scheduled and may be called upon to help with election tasks if necessary, such as answering phones, directing citizens, processing mail-in ballots, etc.

Because employees will be working late through the night, the County's Motor Vehicle offices in Aurora, Byers, Centennial and Littleton will reopen to the public at 10 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 7.
