## **Arapahoe County celebrates National Public Works Week**

*As part of National Public Works Week, Arapahoe County provided free disposal services for residents during Strasburg Cleanup*

**Denver, Colo.** --- Arapahoe County celebrated National Public Works Week, May 20 – 26, by hosting a free community cleanup in Strasburg. Six 90 yard dumpsters were filled with useless items such as tree limbs, old lawn furniture, and scrap lumber in an effort to spruce up local homes and tidy up the neighborhood.

Public Works oversees the development of unincorporated Arapahoe County, which includes improvements, operations and maintenance of public infrastructure. Divisions include Road and Bridge, Transportation, Planning, Engineering Services, Building and Support Services.

“From animal control and zoning to building permits and road planning and improvement, Public Works serves to keep the county operating smoothly,” said Arapahoe County Commissioner Rod Bockenfeld, who serves District 3, which includes portions of Aurora, Centennial, Foxfield and the communities of eastern Arapahoe County. “Some of their most recent accomplishments include the completion of the Parker and Arapahoe Road Construction Project, development of the Rural Engineering Standards, and revisions to the County’s Land Development Code.”

D&D Water Services supplied the dumpsters and Strasburg Park and Recreation offered to host the event on site. The Spring Cleanup is just one way the County is partnering with the community to provide a cost effective way to help residents discard unused outdoor items.
