Good news for dog lovers – Arapahoe County’s licensing online *Arapahoe County’s dog licensing forms can now be completed online*

ARAPAHOE COUNTY, CO --- Residents living in Unincorporated Arapahoe County now have the ability to license their dogs online at www.licensepet.com/arapahoe making it easier and more convenient to keep your pet safe. On average, Arapahoe County licenses more than 1,200 dogs per year.

The benefits of licensing man's best friend are many. Reuniting a lost dog with his owner becomes much easier if the pet is licensed, and licensed dogs have received the required rabies vaccine which keeps pets and their families healthy.

When licensing your pet, be sure to have the following information: dog's name, breed, color, gender, current rabies vaccination number and dates of inoculation, e-mail address, and major credit card (there is a \$1.25 processing fee for online purchases).

The annual fee is \$12 for spayed/ neutered dogs and \$24 for unsprayed/non-neutered dogs. As an added convenience, residents can purchase a three-year license for \$36 or \$72 respectively. Seniors above the age of 65 receive their first dog license free, and additional pets are licensed at the regular rate.
