Arapahoe County Commissioner Frank Weddig named chairman of E-470 Public Highway Authority Board of Directors

Littleton, Colo. --- Arapahoe County Commissioner Frank Weddig recently was appointed to serve as Chair of the E-470 Public Highway Authority Board of Directors.

"I am very pleased to have the opportunity to serve as chair of this board," said Weddig, who is serving his second term as County Commissioner representing District 5, which includes Aurora. "E-470 is an important amenity to the eastern part of Arapahoe County and to commuters in the Denver metro area."

The E-470 Public Highway Authority maintains the tolled eastern beltway of Denver, which uses the Express Toll electronic collection system. The Board of Directors considers setting rates, charges for services, maintenance and expansion of the highway. It is comprised of representatives from each of its eight member jurisdictions including Adams County, Arapahoe County, Douglas County, City of Aurora, City of Brighton, City of Thornton, Commerce City and the Town of Parker.

Weddig has served on the E-470 Board of Directors since 2006. As commissioner, he also serves on the Developmental Pathways Board of Directors, Board of Social Services, Colorado Counties Inc, General Government and Tourism and Economic committees, Aurora Chamber Board of Directors and the South Metro Drug Task Force Forfeiture Board.
