Arapahoe County to mail General Election ballots next week *Voters should expect to receive their mail-in ballots in mailboxes October 14 - 15*

Littleton, Colo. --- Arapahoe County voters will soon receive their ballots in the mail for the Nov. 2, 2010 General Election.

“Ballots will be mailed to all registered voters who have requested to receive a mail-in ballot,” said Clerk and Recorder Nancy A. Doty, adding that nearly 200,000 ballots will be mailed beginning Oct. 12. “If you would like to vote by mail, there is still time to request a ballot.”

Arapahoe County voters who would like to receive a mail-in ballot have until Oct. 26 to request a ballot to be mailed and Oct. 29 to pick up a mail-in ballot in person.

Along with their ballot, voters will receive instructions on how to fill out their ballot, as well as options for returning their ballot to the County. Doty said voters should use a black or blue ball point pen, and should avoid using Sharpie or felt-tip marker pens as they can bleed through the ballot.

Voters can mail their ballot to the County by placing 61 cents in postage on the envelope, or they can drop their ballot at any of the following 15 Mail-in Ballot Drop-off locations:

Voters who prefer to cast their ballot in person and wish to vote early, can visit one of eight Early Voting Centers, which are available Oct. 18 through Oct. 29. Visit www.arapahoevotes.com for times and locations.

In addition, Arapahoe County is offering Voter Assistance Centers where voters will be able to register to vote, update voter registration, emergency register, request a new ballot, request a replacement ballot and drop off their voted mail ballot.
