## **Inverness Bridge over Cottonwood Creek complete**

*Arapahoe County and Inverness Metropolitan Improvement District complete traffic enhancements to Inverness Bridge*

**Centennial, CO** – Drivers, cyclists and pedestrians on Inverness Bridge now experience safer driving conditions that include the ability to see further ahead and gage roadway conditions and greater clearance between lanes, thanks to the completion of a lane-widening project by Arapahoe County and the Inverness Metropolitan Improvement District.

The Inverness Drive East bridge, located just north of the East Inverness Place Cul-de-Sac, was widened as part of the County's annual bridge rehabilitation program.
