- b. Safety Presentation, “Working in the Heat” by Jeff Kaiser, Road and Bridge Safety Trainer.
 - i. Always use sun screen
 - ii. Drink water before you feel thirsty
 - iii. Supplement electrolytes and sodium with something besides water, such as: Gatorade or Propel, etc.
 - iv. Dress appropriately: wear light weight, light colored clothing and a hat
 - v. Heat stroke or exhaustion can happen even on a cloudy day
 - vi. Avoid caffeine and alcohol since they dehydrate the body
 - vii. If someone shows symptoms of heat exhaustion or heat stroke which are:
 1. Sweaty, pale, vomiting, high body temperature, cramping, loss of consciousness, dry mouth, seizures
 2. Get them to a cooler spot, cool down their bodies gradually with cool towels.
 3. Heat stroke requires medical attention.

- c. New committee formed to discuss problems with utility placement and work that is done in County ROW. We need more representation from the telecommunications groups on this committee, please contact Joseph Boateng if interested. We need to discuss placement of utilities, pothole repair and placement, utility lines in the ROW, etc. Remember: the conduit must go where it was approved to go.
 - d. CDOT said they are having a problem with contractors not filling potholes correctly. Polonia asked how CDOT coordinates the contractors and the work done in the County. For instance, work done on Parker? How do we make sure contractors that are working for CDOT in County ROW do the work correctly? CDOT: we make sure that the inspectors check the work and approve the work correctly.
 - e. There seems to be a problem communicating with XCEL. The County will try reaching out to them and make sure they are invited to next Utility Coordination Meeting. (Judy to reach out to Tom Henley). Someone asked, “if they don’t come to the next meeting, can we withhold permit approval? Chuck said maybe.
 - f. Jon Warford: The project at Parker and Mississippi will be huge and affect everyone. It is Denver & County Open Space project (Roger Harvey). Schedule is unknown at this time.
