




Commuting to Work

The ACS asks respondents to report on their means of commuting to work. While all districts had over 70 percent of their working residents driving to work alone, the variation among districts is significant. District 3 has the highest percentage at 82 percent while District 2 has the most people driving alone at 50,100. District 5 has the lowest percentage of driving alone at 71 percent and the largest number of carpoolers and public transportation users.

With the large area in District 3, it is not surprising that it has the lowest number of public transportation users. It is interesting that it has the second highest number of carpoolers. This might suggest that some marketing of carpool services in this District would be effective.


District 2 has the most persons who worked at home, with 5,000. District 5 only had 1,400 residents who worked at home.

Means of Transportation to Work Walked, Bicycle, and Other, 2014



The numbers of walkers, bicycle commuters and users of other means are so small that they are hard to see on the chart. The second chart provides more detail for those modes.

Districts 5 had the most walkers and District 1, the most bicycle commuters. From this survey, the number of bicycle commuters was even lower than the numbers who reported some other means of commuting.

Another key indicator of commuting is the travel time to work. As expected, District 3 with the far eastern portion of Arapahoe County has the longest median travel time at 30 minutes. District 5, where many people use public transit has the second highest at 28 minutes. Tract 71.01, in the far east of the County has the longest average commute time at 38.8 minutes. Several tracts, including 71.1, have 18 percent or more of their works commuting more than an hour to work.
